

Year End High Point and All Around Award Rules

Eligibility

- The owner and the exhibitor must be a current ILQHA member
- The horse must be registered with AQHA
- Must show in the same class in a minimum of 5 shows

Guidelines

- Year End High Point awards are calculated on the horse/exhibitor combination earning the most points in each class with the exception of open horse events.
- Points are counted beginning January 1 until September 30.
- Points will be counted in ILQHA approved classes at ILQHA approved shows or events.
- Points are awarded based on the official AQHA show results.
- An exhibitor may ask for a review within 5 days of the updated points being posted.
- All decisions will be made by the ILQHA Board of Directors and are final.
- The official class list for Year End High Point awards is posted on the ILQHA website
- Transfer of ownership
 - Points earned in an open division will transfer to the new owner providing the new owner is a current member.
 - Points earned in youth, amateur, small fry and EWD are not transferrable.

All Around Awards will be offered in the following:

- Halter Open Level 1 Amateur Amateur Select Level 1 Youth Youth 13 and Under Youth 14-18 Small Fry EWD
- To be eligible for an All Around a horse/exhibitor combination must have a minimum of 5 points in at least 3 different events in the same division. For example, a horse showing in Amateur Showmanship, Amateur Horsemanship and Amateur HUS would be eligible for the Amateur All Around Award.
- In the Open Division Level 1 points do not count towards the Open All Around Award
